Rath Trevor Beach Provincial Park: Spring Programs



May through June 2016

Grades K/1 1 hour \$5+GST per student (min \$125+GST per class)

Senses, observations, local plants & animals, compare/describe

- 1) **Feeling Crabby?** We are always crabby in the intertidal zone of Rath Trevor Beach! Learn about these local animals and see if you can find one or 100 on the beach.
- 2) **Bodacious Bugs!** What's a bug? Find out as we inspect the insects of the area and learn some nifty sampling and ID techniques.
- 3) **Slug Shuffle** Join us as we "break-it-down" with one of our favourite decomposers- the slug!

Grades 2/3 1 hour \$5+GST per student (min \$125+GST per class)

Senses, observations, animals, plants, interactions, structures

- 1) **Intertidal Survival** When the tide is out a whole new world is revealed and it's not an easy place to live in. See how animals and plants survive in the Intertidal Zone!
- 2) **Froggy Frog World** Leap into a frogs life where metamorphosis will transform you from egg to frog!
- 3) **May the Forest be With You** The forces of nature can reveal secrets of the forest: What's edible? What's not? What's the use of that? & Who is home?

Grades 4/5 1 hour \$5+GST per student (min \$125+GST per class)

Predictions, animals, plants, habitats, food chains, communities, respect

- 1) **Intertidal Zone-dicular Dude!** Life in the intertidal zone is totally gnarly! You'll be amazed how creatures and plants must adapt to live in this habitat!
- 2) **Look at that...a Habitat!** From the micro to the macro- Miracle Beach's habitats are everywhere! See who lives where and who eats who in this park's community.

Grades 5/6/7 2.5 hours \$10+GST per student min charge for 20 students

Resources, interconnectedness, impacts, life forms, adaptations, communities, food webs, ecosystems.

- 1) **Seashore Discovery Program** Get an inside look at Rath Trevor Beach as we lead your students on an exploratory journey of the sea shore. Identify marine habitats, animal adaptations and discover the spineless wonders of the intertidal zone.
- 2) **Forest Discovery Program** Ever wonder how to identify your local trees and native plants? Or how you could make a cup of tea in the forest? Forests are important to all living things and play a significant role in all of our lives. Explore the life in a forest and see how plants, animals, fungi and microscopic organisms all depend on each other.
