NOVEMBER 2nd TO DECEMBER 18th 2020

These programs will differ from previous years due to COVID-19 safety adaptations. Groups making bookings will be provided with our Goldstream Nature House Covid-19 Safety Plan and a copy of your group's Field Trip Safety Plan will be required.



1. SALMON STORYBOOK TIME - GRADES: K-3 Younger students discover the salmon life-cycle with an over-sized storybook. Outside story-time is followed by a salmon habitat exploration and may include a salmon dissection-if available. (BY DONATION \$75 one class only)

2. THE CHUM SALMON CYCLE - GRADES: 4-8 Introduce your class to the life-cycle of the Pacific Salmon with a focus on specific courtship and spawning behaviours of the Chum salmon that can be observed in the Goldstream River. The program involves an outdoor presentation followed by a salmon habitat exploration. May include a salmon dissection -if available. (BY DONATION \$75 one class only)

3. THE SALMON FOREST - GRADES 4-9 Imagine a tree eating a salmon!? Discover the secrets of our diverse coastal forests and how they depend on healthy populations of salmon returning each year. Learn about the connection between plants, bears, songbirds, and insects and delve in the concepts of nutrient cycling and forest ecology. May include a salmon dissection -if available. (BY DONATION \$75 one class only)

4. EDDIE THE EAGLE AND THE ESTUARY - GRADES: K-7 Discover the success story of the Eagles at Goldstream and the amazing life history of these much-loved birds with an over-sized storybook and interactive presentation. We will cross our fingers that they show up for viewing in the Estuary! (BY DONATION \$75 one class only)
