



Job Title: *Park Naturalist – Salmon Run Season*

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Programs will be presented in the Goldstream Nature House based out of Goldstream Provincial Park and will include school programs and public programs during the salmon run.
- Other programs may include sleepovers about nocturnal animals, birds of prey, and salmon.
- The applicant will also be involved in staffing and maintaining the Goldstream Nature House, and The Goldstream Welcome Centre which promotes the Provincial Parks protected areas. This includes answering questions, maintaining exhibits, operating a gift store, serving concession type food and cleaning duties.

Training/Supervision:

- Training will involve on-site salmon run training with senior staff.
- The applicant will work under the supervision of the Goldstream Nature House Manager.

- Must be willing and able to work weekends, evenings, statutory holidays.
